Dear Unity Reed HS Seniors and Families,

As we continue to build our school culture, increase school spirit, and support senior class, the administration of Unity Reed High School has agreed to allow <u>senior students</u> to paint their parking spaces. There are a limited number of spaces available for painting, choosing to decorate your space allows you to not only personalize your space, but creates a dedicated parking space for you, during school hours.

The cost of parking fees at Prince William County Schools is \$100 per space—this cost is set by the school division. If you would like to **paint your parking space**, **the cost is an additional \$20**, which is non-refundable. **Both payments may be made in cash, check, or money order to Unity Reed High School;** however, they must be paid separately: one check (or cash) for \$100 and one check (or cash) for \$20.

For \$20, students may paint a **pre-approved** design of their choice. To participate, seniors must:

- Submit a signed "Painted Parking Space Contract" and "Design Request" between July 30th -September 26th to <u>Mrs. Nash</u> (Senior Class Assistant Principal) or <u>Mrs. Pryce</u> (Senior Class Administrative Assistant) in the 3rd Floor office for approval.
- 2. Purchase a Unity Reed High School parking permit from Mr. Bouchard (Security Officer).
 - When purchasing your parking permit, you must also bring the following items in order to claim your paintable parking space:
 - A signed copy of the "Painted Parking Space Contract" (attached)
 - Your design proposal with signature showing it is approved. Please make a copy or take a picture for your records.
 - Cash, check, or money order for \$20 made out to Unity Reed High School
- 3. If you want to reserve parking spaces with a group of individuals, all students must be present with paperwork completed when coming to purchase the parking spots. They cannot be held for individuals who are not there at the time of purchase.
- Painting will take place from 10:00 AM 1:00 PM Saturday, August 10th, August 17th, 2024 and September 28th 11-2:30 (following the Senior Breakfast event).

The design should be completed on the "Senior Parking Design Request" form. This should be <u>completed in</u> <u>color</u> and be an <u>exact representation</u> of what you plan to paint on your space. Adjustments to designs will not be permitted on the day of painting. Once submitted, all designs will be approved by the administration. All designs are expected to be painted over in black, water-based latex exterior paint, prior to graduation by one of the following options:

- Students can choose to paint their design over themselves on an approved paint date-TBA
- Students can choose to pay an additional \$20 to have the S.A.V.E. Club paint it for them.

Because these designs will be displayed on school property and could have the appearance of being school and school-district endorsed, designs that are religious, political, or controversial in nature will not be approved. The administration of Unity Reed High School reserves the right to not allow any design that it deems offensive or controversial. The judgment of appropriateness of design is at the sole discretion of the school administration.

Prohibited designs include, but are not limited to:

- Offensive language, pictures, or symbols
- Negative or rude language
- Gang-style tagging
- Double entendre (double meaning)
- Other student's names or likeness



- □ **<u>*Water-based exterior latex paint</u>** (at least 1 gallon for base and 1 quart or ½ gallon for accent colors)
- □ Water-based exterior latex primer (if paint doesn't come with primer)
- □ Sidewalk chalk to sketch out design before painting
- Painters tape to mark off 4" border
- Paint trays
- Paint brushes
- Paint rollers
- Paint roller extensions
